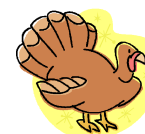

Large Item Pick Up Program

All American Waste (AAW) offers a **pick up program** for up to 3 large items (Effective 2/1/2011): 1 item = \$50, 2 items = \$100, & 3 = \$150. Call 860-289-7850 to make arrangements. NOTE: Resident must pay prior to pick up.



Oversized (Large or Bulky) Items & Metal Drop Off

There will be an Oversized Item dropoff scheduled twice within the year. Spring and Fall. Next dropoff is scheduled for Saturday, September 29, 2012 (Fall Collection) at the F&G Volume Reduction Station, 9 Shoham Road (off of Route 140), East Windsor from 7:30AM-11:30AM. 6-Yard Construction Can Rental

USA Hauling & Recycling is offering a 6-yard Construction Can (approx. 6 ft. x 6 ft. x 6 ft. tall) for bulky items at a special rate of \$110.00 per haul and \$75 per ton. Call 860-746-3200 to arrange delivery.



Car Batteries & Waste Oil

To be picked up on recycle days only. Put waste oil in a screw-top container and place container(s) to the side of the blue (recycle) bin at least 2 feet away in plain sight for pick up. Place car batteries to the side of the blue bin also 2 feet away. DO NOT place inside the blue bin (or trash bin).

East Windsor uses Single Stream Recycling (as of September 21, 2009).

Soft Cover Books
Direct Mail / Envelopes (all types)
Paper / Boxboard (e.g. Cereal / Shoe Boxes)
Milk & Juice Cartons (e.g. Aseptic Packaging)
Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags
Plastic Bottles & Containers #s 1 – 7
Soda / Juice / Water Bottles (Glass or Plastic)
Plastic Food Containers (cleaned) #s 1 - 7 or Alum Trays
Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)
Aluminum Pie Plates / Trays / Foil (cleaned)
Metal Cans (Tin / Steel / Aluminum) and Steel Aerosol Cans
Juice Boxes without straws (e.g. Hi-C boxes; not Capri Sun)



NOT ACCEPTABLE IN BLUE BIN

No Plastic Bags or Food Liners
No Unmarked Plastics (with no number)
No Window Glass, Light Bulbs, or Mirrors
No Dishes, Pyrex, or Ceramics
No Foam Packaging or Styrofoam
No Hazardous Materials or Yard Waste
No Recyclables Containing Food Waste
No Telephone Books
No Ice Cream Cartons
No Pots and Pans, Hangars or Toys
No CDs or DVDs
No Electronics or Batteries
No Pizza Boxes

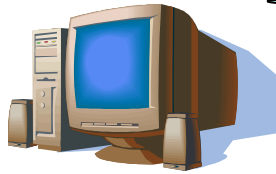

TIPS ON (T) TRASH AND (R) RECYCLING:

- **Cans/Bottles/Boxes:** Should be free and clear of any food residue. Bottles and cans should be rinsed. (R)
- **Latex Paint:** Dry its contents first before disposal. Use Speedy Dry or Kitty Litter to dry contents and then put in regular trash. Do not throw in trash bin unless it is dry. (T)
- **Paper/Cardboard/Boxboard:** Make sure envelopes and boxboard are free of any food residue. Plastic windows (such as in window envelopes and pasta boxes) should be removed before recycling. (R)
- **Propane Tanks:** Refer to pages 17 of the MDC haz waste info pack <http://www.themdc.com/haz10infopack.pdf> (This lists companies that will take gas grill tanks. It is recommended that you call before going.)
Sometimes acceptable at haz waste collections. (Haz Waste)
- **Telephone books** are not recyclable in East Windsor. Please call Public Works for more information (860-292-7073). (T)
- **Tires** should be rim-free. Make sure tires are off of the rim. **One in trash bin per week is acceptable.** (T)

Televisions, Computers, Printers, and Monitors are to be disposed of at East Windsor Department of Public Works.

These items no longer accepted at F&G Volume Reduction (Transfer) Station (by USA Hauling/All American Waste).

Yard Waste Collections (2 per year)



Yard Waste Collections will be held twice a year: one in the Spring and one in the Fall. This year's Fall (2012) collection will be Monday, November 26, through Friday, November 30. Note that the pickup day will be on your assigned trash pickup day. Items are to be left curbside by 6:00 a.m. that day. More details on the Yard Waste collection can be found on East Windsor's web site. Notifications for these collections are posted on the www.patch.com (in Windsor Locks-East Windsor section), in the Journal Inquirer and in the Reminder News at least one or two weeks prior to the occurrence.

Yard waste and brush are to be left curbside by 6:00 A.M. on your regular trash day. **Yard waste must be in biodegradable paper bags.** Brush must be bundled and cut into 4 ft. lengths and less than 6" in diameter. Yard waste will be collected in special trucks, not the regular trash trucks. If you are unable to participate in the Spring and Fall collections you have the option of calling GreenCycle at (860) 871-7442.

Acceptable Yard Waste for the Town:

- Brush (4 ft lengths, less than 6" in diameter)
- Tree limbs and branches (4 ft lengths, less than 6" in diameter)
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves
