## **Registration Policies and Procedures**



**Program Information:** The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department has the right to cancel, reschedule or relocate a program or event according to facility availability and public participation. We may also enforce a minimum and/or maximum number of participants needed to make a program viable. Our programs are self funding which means in order for them to run we need to get the enrollment that is necessary. Please don't wait until the last minute to sign up. These programs are for you and your children and cannot be held without participation. So sign up Today!! Thank you for your support.

**Registration Process:** The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department accepts registration on an in-person basis during posted office hours. We also accept registration through the mail-in process. Programs are on a first-come first-serve basis, and we must obtain enough registrations to make the program successful. Non-residents can register for our programs; special fees will be posted on a class-by-class basis.



**Payment / Refund Policies:** Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration unless otherwise stated in the program information. We accept cash and checks payable to "East Windsor Parks and Recreation." Returned checks will be charged a \$15 fee.

**NO REFUNDS will be given unless extenuating circumstances prevents you from participating in the program. The cost of trips is also non-refundable.**

**Summer Soccer Camp:** The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department is sponsoring a youth soccer camp at East Windsor Middle School. Instructors will include the East Windsor High School Varsity Girls Soccer Coach Mark Jordan and some of his players. Camp will be held August 12<sup>th</sup>, 13th, 14th and will be \$80.00 for the week, \$5 per sibling discount. Camp runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and is for athletes entering grades 4-9. Cleats, Shin guards, sneakers, water bottle and lunch must be brought every day. This camp is open to both residents and non-residents. **Summer Cheerleading Camp:** We are once again sponsoring a summer cheer program. Instructors will include Sharon Orefice EW Middle School Cheerleading Coach and members of the Varsity Cheerleading Team. New for this year we will be working in conjunction with the new gymnastics school “Air Time Gymnastics” which is located next door to the high school. **Summer Gymnastics Camp:** We will be sponsoring a new and exciting program for Summer 2008. Air Time Gymnastics will be holding a Summer Gymnastics Camp for boys and girls entering grades K-6. Camp will run August 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to Noon. This camp will be held at the Air Time Facility located at 84 South Main St, next door to EW High School. **Swim Lessons at East Windsor Park:** Swimming lessons for children will be held at the East Windsor Park, Reservoir Ave., Broad Brook, beginning June 23rd. The lessons will be for all levels from pre-beginners to the advanced swimmer. Student must attain the age 5 as of December 31, 2008. Registration will be held at the East Windsor Park gatehouse. The gatehouse is open from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on the weekends only starting June 6<sup>th</sup>. The park will open daily for the season beginning June 21st; hours of operation will then be 9:00 am – 7:00 pm. For questions, please call the East Windsor Park gatehouse at 623-8375. **Summer Fun in the Park:** Summer Fun in the Park summer camp is back for children ages 6-12! Camp will be held Monday through Thursday at the East Windsor Park. Sessions are one week long and will include a different theme every week. Field Trips will be taken once per session and will cost between \$6 and \$10 per child. Camp T-shirt will be sold for \$8.00 and **must be worn** on all field trips. Please indicate child's size on registration form. Registration will close **ONE WEEK** before each session. NO Phone Registrations will be accepted. See registration form for details. **First session of Camp will be July 7-10th.** **Camp Hours and Fees:** **9 a.m. to 3 p.m.:** \$70 per week for the first child, \$65 per week for each additional child. **7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.:** \$80 per week for the first child, \$75 per week for each additional child. Non-Residents add \$10 per week per child. Upon registration, a **NON-Refundable \$10.00** deposit per child is required to reserve your spot per session. Balance must be paid before the first day of each session otherwise Camper will NOT be allowed at Camp. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! Space is Limited!! Sign up Early!!**



**Tiny Tots Summer Fun:** Tiny Tots summer fun is back for children ages 4 & 5. Camp will be held at East Windsor Park Monday through Thursday. Tiny Tot Fun Camp is run separate from Summer Fun Camp but some activities will be combined such as Lunch and Free Swim. Half Day Campers do not go swimming, but will use the sprinkler on a daily basis. Field Trips are not available to Tiny Tots, but special interest events will be brought to the camp. **First session of Camp will be July 7-10.** **Fees:** Half-Day Camp: 9 a.m. to Noon: \$50 per week \$45 each additional child. Full-Day Camp is the same as Summer Fun Camp. **Space is Limited to 10 campers per session.** T-shirts are available for \$8, but are not required to attend camp.
